



following this up with the relevant Council Officers and will provide the precinct with a response as soon as possible.

Resolution 1/15: Request Council to remove all bushes on the left side of Little Bay Rd at approach to Bunnerong Rd roundabout.

The precinct's resolution regarding this issue has been sent to Council's Coordinator Open Space Services I will contact the precinct with a response once I receive it. I can also advise that extensive pruning and removal work was undertaken at this spot as recently as December 2014; I have enclosed photographs to show the works carried out.

Resolution 2/15: Request Council to push for a referendum where residents are asked a Yes or No to the question *Do you want Randwick Council to amalgamate with any other Council*

Council will be holding a plebiscite (poll) in May 2015.

I can also advise that since January 2015, Council has undertaken extensive Community Consultation in order to help us understand the community's attitudes to council amalgamations and help inform Council's position and submission to the State Government.

Most recently, in February, Council sent every resident, rate payer and business owner a community survey which poses the question, amongst others, "Should Randwick City Council be amalgamated?" and gives the options for reply as yes / no / unsure.

Once the survey closes, on 1<sup>st</sup> March, Council will collate the thousands of responses it has received and consider its preferred position before submitting this for exhibition and eventual submission to the NSW State Government.

Have Frenchmans Beach declared a "swimming" beach.

The movement and mooring of boats at Frenchmans Bay is under the control of the Roads and Maritime Service and their website shows that Frenchmans Bay has courtesy mooring sites.
